A trip to the outskirts along the 'Ambassador Row', Istana Sharif Ali and Malay Villages. Our Stop at the Royal Selangor Pewter will feature the largest and most modern pewter factory in the world, internationally reputed for its high quality and craftsmanship. You will be shown the

different processes, such as casting, filling to polishing, soldering, hammering and engraving during this factory tour. Next we stop at the Batik Factory -see how Batik is designed and printed. Our last stop will be at the limestone hills of Batu Caves that comprises of three caverns and several smaller caves. It is the shrine of Lord Murugah, a Hindu deity – A flight of 272 steps leadup to the temple cave. Another cave, called the museum cave, is filled with images of deities and murals depicting scenes from the Hindu Scriptures.

Highlights: The Sri Mahamariamman Temple - The smell of burning jasmine, the incessant chanting of Hindu priests and the mystical aura will all combine to give you an ever-lasting impression of this fascinating religion. A short walk from here is

The Open Air Bazaar of Chinatown - Take a stroll through this night market where the locals engage in hectic bargaining for merchandises spread across the middle of the street. From here, we drive you to a delightful Malay Restaurant where you will be treated to a Malay Buffet Dinner And Cultural Show. Help yourself to the buffet dinner where a sumptuous variety of local delicacies awaits you. While you have your feast you will be entertained to an array of Malaysian Cultural Dances.

Depart Kuala Lumpur with a brief stop during the journey. We arrive in the historical city of Malacca with a visit to St. Peter's church, the oldest Christian Church still in use. Drive past Bukit

China or Chinese Hill. Stop at the foothill to view the Sultan's Well before driving through the Portuguese Settlement. Afterwards, we will proceed to the famous gateway "Porta de Santiago" & the ruins of St. Paul's Church lined by 17th century Dutch tombstones. Next on the list is the City Square, the salmon Pink Dutch administrative buildings known as Stadhuys, which today houses the Malacca Museum & some of the government offices. After lunch (optional), visit the Cheng Hoon Teng temple, the only temple where you can find 2 major doctrines of local Chinese belief under the same roof, namely Taoism, Buddhism, and Confucianism. Take a walk down Malacca's antique street which ends by the bank of the Malacca River. The tour will depart Malacca at approximately 1730 hrs, returning to KL.

7. KUALA SELANGOR FIRE FLIES TOUR

Proceed to Kuala Selangor town in the quiet hamlet of Kampung Kuantan, site of one of the largest firefly colonies in the world.

On arrival at Kuala Selangor, visit 'Kota Melawati' formerly known as 'Fort Altingsburg', the execution block, royal mausoleum and colonial buildings. A bird sanctuary park at the foot of Bukit Melawati is an ideal place for bird-watchers to watch local any migratory birds. Also found are silvered-leaf monkeys, butterflies and etc.

Next proceed to Kampung Kuantan, which is the highlight of the tour. Row upstream in a small un-motorised boat (tongkang) in the quiet darkness to witness the blinking Rees. This scintillating display of fireflies portrays an image of a flashing Christmas tree. The synchronized, rhythmic flashing is produced by the thousand of fireflies found in the mangrove swamp of Kampung Kuantan. The skilled local oarsmen make this experience a memorable and unforgettable one.

The journey from Kuala Lumpur to Putra Jaya takes approximately 50 minutes via the highway. Our first stop will be Taman Warisan or Agricultural Heritage Park - a living museum for mango, rubber, coca, palm oil, durian, jackfruits, herb and etc. Next proceed to Putrajaya Government Centre, there are numerous new government complexes located in this new townships. The most imposing structure in Putrajaya is the thin pinkish Putra Mosque. Standing beside Dataran Putra and facing the Putrajaya Lake, it incorporates architectural elements from Turkistan, Kazakhstan and Morocco. Another eye-catching building is the Prime Minister's office - Putra Perdana. Other interesting places are Putra Bridge and the Prime Minister's residence.

The journey takes approximately 1 hour 45 minutes. Our first stop is the Aborigine Settlement. Kuala Gandah Elephant Conservation was established in 1989 by the Department of wildlife and National parks. The centre is a base for the Elephant Relocation Team, which began the elephant translocations problem programme in 1974. The only one of its kind in Malaysia, the team is dedicated to locating, subduing and then translocation problem elephants from areas where their habitats are constantly being encroached by plantations and to other suitable habitats throughout the Peninsular such as Taman Negara. Over the past 25 years the centre has helped prevent the further declined of the elephant population by relocating more than 300 wild elephants. Tour includes elephant ride, elephant feeding and for those who are brave; we suggest you bring a change of clothes and towel if you wish to participate in water activities such as swimming and bathing the elephant in the river.
